Teasing and opening the fibre into a **SLIVER** ready for further preparation.

First & Second Gill aligning and straightening the fibres ready for Combing.

Combing Removing short fibres (NOIL), veg matter and other contamination from the fibre taxe

Levelling the tops after combing by passing them through an Autolevelling Gillbox.

Drawing Reducing the fibre down into a heavy Roving ready for further reduction.



Spinning

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Producing a fine Roving on a bobbin from which yarn can be spun.

Drawing or drafting the fibre into a very fine stream and then inserting twist.

Coning


Skeining

Repackaging the spun singles yarn onto a cone ready for Folding or Plying.

Combining the spun singles with each other to fold or ply them together into a finished yarn.

Winding the finished yarn into a skein ready for hand crochet or knitting.
