

Colourwork Mitts by Marina Skua Sportweight or DK




Inspired by the beautiful combinations of textures, motifs and muted colours of rural smocks, these knitted mitts are a contemporary take on traditional patterning.

Worked in either <u>Devonia DK</u> or <u>Yarnadelic Sport</u>, the pattern includes a collection of textured and colourwork stitches and the mitts are finished with a simple button to add a classic twist and extra snugness around the wrists.

Skills Used: working in the round, colourwork, increasing, slipped stitches

Yarn requirements

Version 1

John Arbon Textiles Devonia (DK; 233m per 100g) MC: Furbelows; 1 skein (all sizes) CC: Sandbar; 1 skein (all sizes)

Actual amount used: 32g of MC, 22g of CC

Version 2

John Arbon Textiles Yarnadelic (sport/heavy 4ply; 333m per 100g) MC: Ordinary Joe; 1 skein (all sizes) CC: Les Fleurs; 1 skein (all sizes)

Approx. amount used: 37g of MC, 27g of CC

You may use any yarn from your own stash (including handspun) as long as it is of the weight specified.

If you wish to knit using our yarns, then we will offer a 15% discount for our test knitters.

Sizes

1 (2, 3)

Finished Measurements

A - Hand circumference: 17.5 (19, 21) cm / 7 (7.75, 8.25)" B - Total length: 17.5 (21, 21) cm / 7 (8.25, 8.25)"

Gauge

24 sts x 25 rows = 10cm / 4" measured over colourwork pattern after blocking, using mid-size needles

Needles & Notions

3mm (UK 11 / US 2.5) circular or double-pointed needles
3.75mm (UK 9 / US 5) circular or double-pointed needles
4.5mm (UK 7 / US 7) circular needles
3mm (US D) crochet hook
1 spare double-pointed needle
3 stitch markers
Waste yarn or stitch holders
2 buttons
