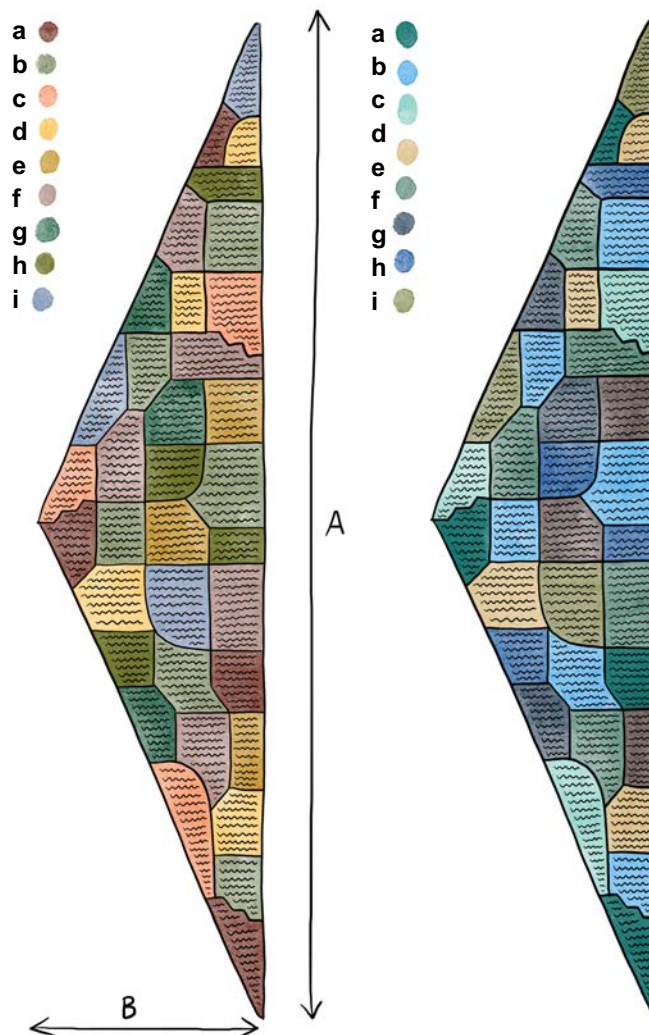


A modern Garter and Intarsia knitting pattern with two colour palettes inspired by the landscape of Exmoor and the seascape of the north-Devon coastline.

Yarn requirements

John Arbon Textiles KBN Minis DK (62m per 25g)

Version 1 - 'Field' Colours

a: 117, 1 mini skein
b: 059, 2 mini skeins
c: 018, 1 mini skein
d: 053, 1 mini skein
e: 111, 1 mini skein
f: 121, 2 mini skeins
g: 044, 1 mini skein
h: 056, 1 mini skein
i: 126, 1 mini skein

Version 2 - 'Shore' Colours

a: 093, 1 mini skein
b: 084, 2 mini skeins
c: 097, 1 mini skein
d: 114, 1 mini skein
e: 008, 1 mini skein
f: 046, 2 mini skeins
g: 123, 1 mini skein
h: 080, 1 mini skein
i: 058, 1 mini skein

You may use any yarn from your own stash (including handspun) as long as it is of the weight specified.

If you wish to knit using our yarns, then we will offer a 15% discount for our test knitters – please be aware that this discount won't apply to our KBN as it is already on sale. Thank you for your understanding.

Sizes

One size

Finished Measurements

A - Wingspan: 188 cm / 74"

B - Maximum depth: 40 cm / 15.75"

Gauge

24 sts x 19 ridges (38 rows) = 10 cm / 4" in garter stitch, measured after washing and blocking.

Needles & Notions

3.5 mm / US 4 circular needles

Always use a pair of needles which results in the correct gauge after blocking.
