



Slip Stitch Hat

Worsted

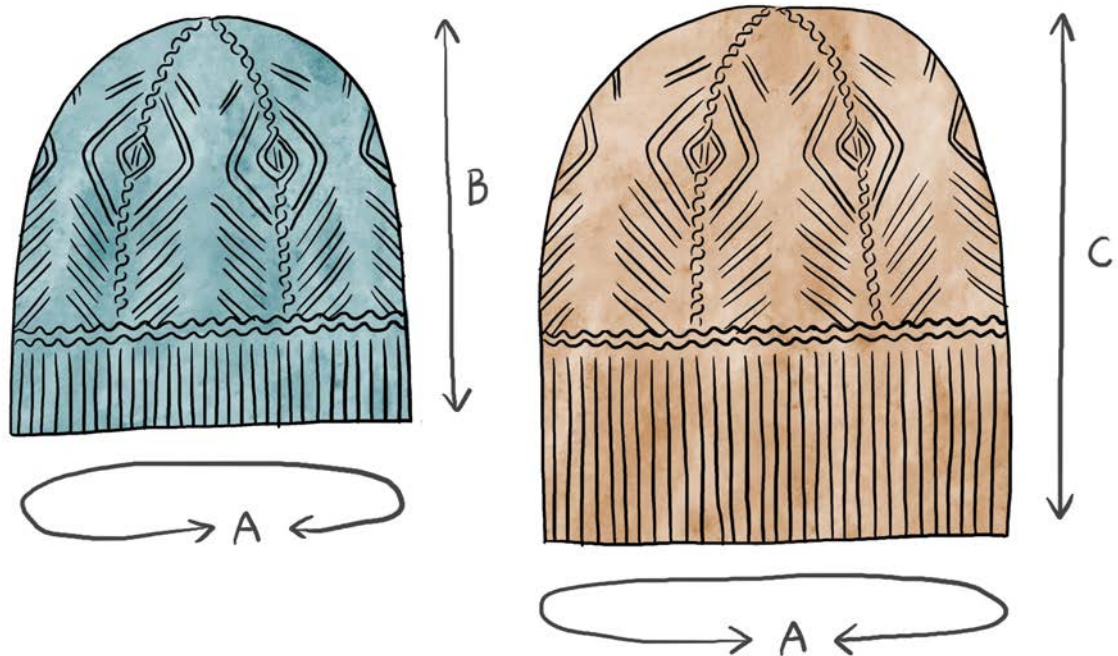


Knitted in autumnal shades from the [Yarnadelic](#) or [Harvest Hues](#) Worsted ranges, this hat makes a warm and cosy knit that's perfect for keeping out the wind on a chilly winter's day on the moors.

Beginning with a tubular cast on, this hat is worked in the round from the bottom up. The single rib brim can either be worked to a short or doubled length and texture is added to the body of the hat using twisted stitches.

Skills Used: working in the round, twisted stitches, decreasing, chart (optional), tubular cast on (optional)

Yarn requirements

Version 1

John Arbon Textiles Yarnadelic (Worsted; 216m per 100g)

Harmonium (song for a) 1 (1, 1, 1) x 100g skein

Version 2

John Arbon Textiles Harvest Hues (Worsted; 200m per 100g)

Russet 1 (1, 1, 1) x 100g skein

You may use any yarn from your own stash (including handspun) as long as it is of the weight specified.

If you wish to knit using our yarns, then we will offer a 15% discount for our test knitters.

Sizes

1 (2, 3, 4)

Toddler (child, small adult, large adult)

Please let us know which size you would make when you submit your request to join the test.

Finished Measurements

A - Hat Circumference: 33 (42, 49.5, 58.5)cm / 13 (16.5, 19.5, 23)"

B - Hat Depth – Standard Brim: 14 (18, 20.5, 23)cm / 5.5 (7, 8, 9)"

C - Hat Depth – Folded Brim: 21.5 (25.5, 28, 30.5)cm / 8.5 (10, 11, 12)"

To be worn with 6-9cm / 2-3.5" negative ease.

Gauge

22 sts x 28 rnds = 10cm/4" over twisted stitch pattern worked in the round after blocking, using larger needles

28 sts x 30 rnds = 10cm/4" over 1x1 twisted rib worked in the round after blocking, using smaller needles

Needles & Notions

3.75mm (9UK / US5) knitting needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round; for main fabric

3.5mm (-UK / US4) knitting needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round; for ribbing

Always use a needle with results in the best gauge after blocking.

Stitch marker

Darning needle

Length of smooth waste yarn (if working tubular cast on)

Pom pom maker (optional)
